

DA cited in accident

SANTA CRUZ — District Attorney Arthur Danner III has been cited for causing a traffic accident in front of the courthouse that injured a Santa Cruz woman.

Danner, 44, was not injured in the accident. The other driver, Sandra Judith Larsen, 28, complained of head, neck and back pain and was transported to Dominican Hospital, where she was treated and released.

According to police reports, Danner was leaving the County Center about 6:40 p.m. on June 9 when he pulled onto Ocean Street in front of Larsen's station wagon. Both cars suffered moderate damage.

Police cited Danner for failing to yield the right of way. Danner told officers he was leaving the County Center parking lot after having been next door at an after-work meeting at the Holiday Inn.
